
2016 Salary Survey Results

Every year at *ADVANCE*, we painstakingly gather data from across the country to produce our eagerly awaited Salary Survey. In addition to our national results, we also offer comprehensive breakdowns by region. 170 people who took our salary survey live in the Midwest region (IN, IL, WI, MN, IA, MO, ND, SD, NE, and KS). 123 of them (72%) were occupational therapists, and 47 (28%) were occupational therapy assistants. This is how the numbers break down for OTs and OTAs who live in the Midwest region of The United States.

Midwest Salary Ranges By Gender 89% of Midwest OTs who completed our salary survey were female.
