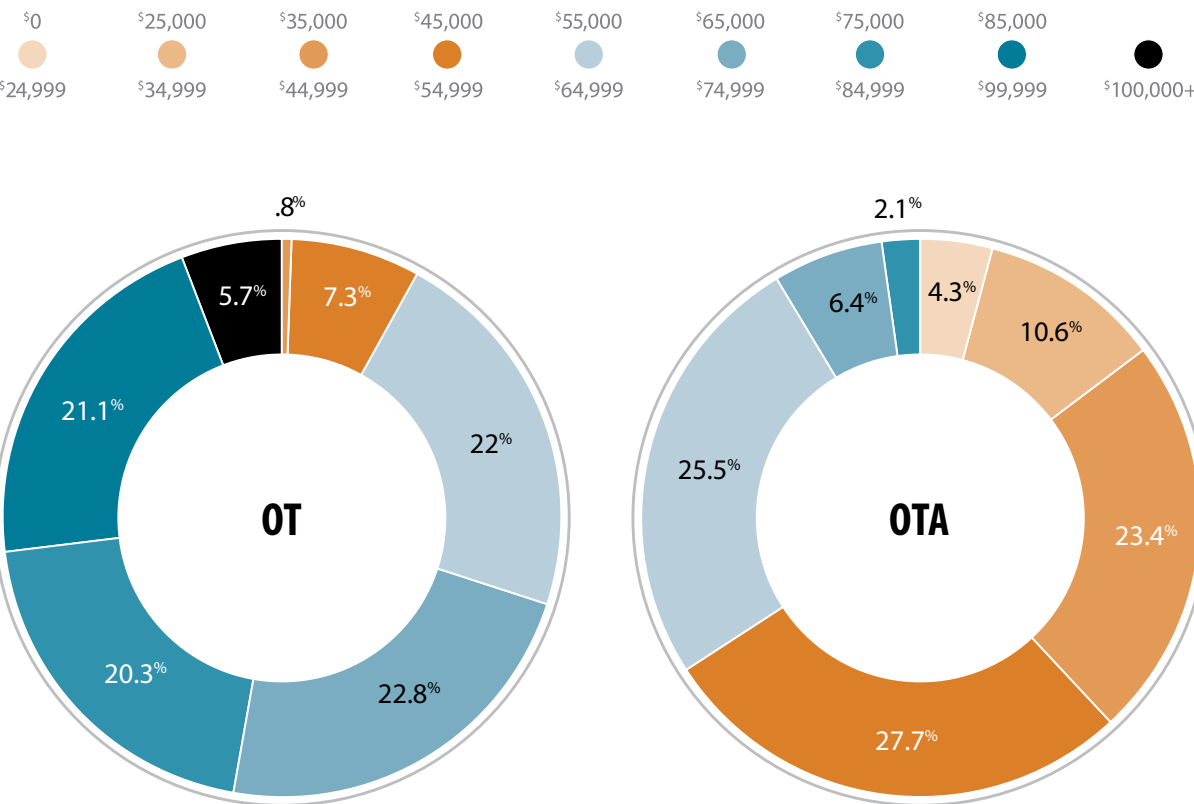


2016 Salary Survey Results

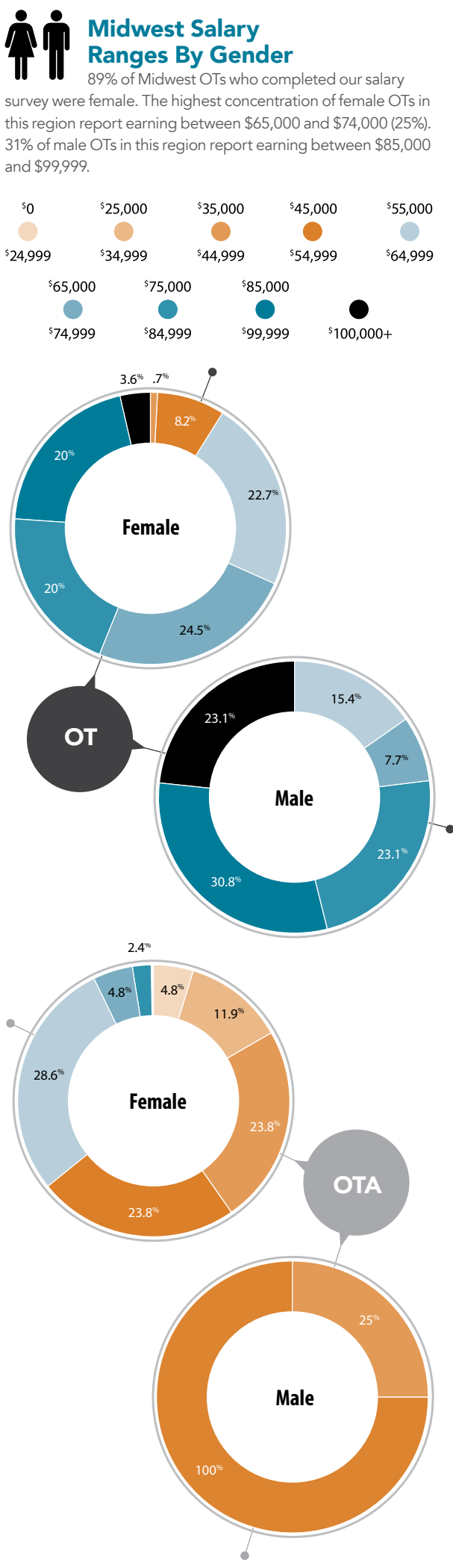
Every year at ADVANCE, we painstakingly gather data from across the country to produce our eagerly awaited Salary Survey. In addition to our national results, we also offer comprehensive breakdowns by region. 170 people who took our salary survey live in the Midwest region (IN, IL, WI, MN, IA, MO, ND, SD, NE, and KS). 123 of them (72%) were occupational therapists, and 47 (28%) were occupational therapy assistants. This is how the numbers break down for OTs and OTAs who live in the Midwest region of The United States.

27% 27% of OTs in in this region report earning at least \$85,000.

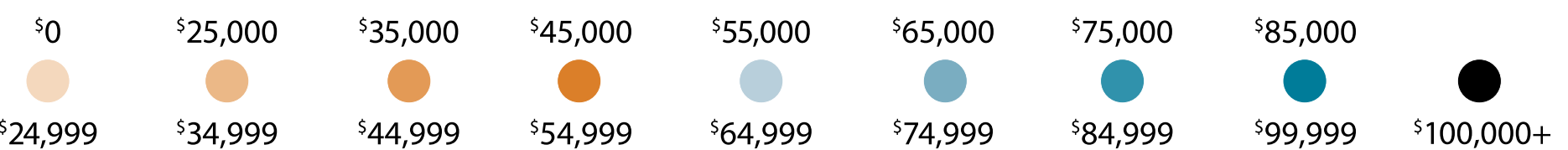
Midwest Salary Ranges For Midwest OTs, the most common salary range was and \$65,000-\$74,999 (23%). Almost half of OT respondents (47%) report earning at least \$75,000. Among Midwest OTAs, the most common range was \$45,000-\$54,999 (25%). About a third (34%) of OTA respondents report earning at least \$55,000.



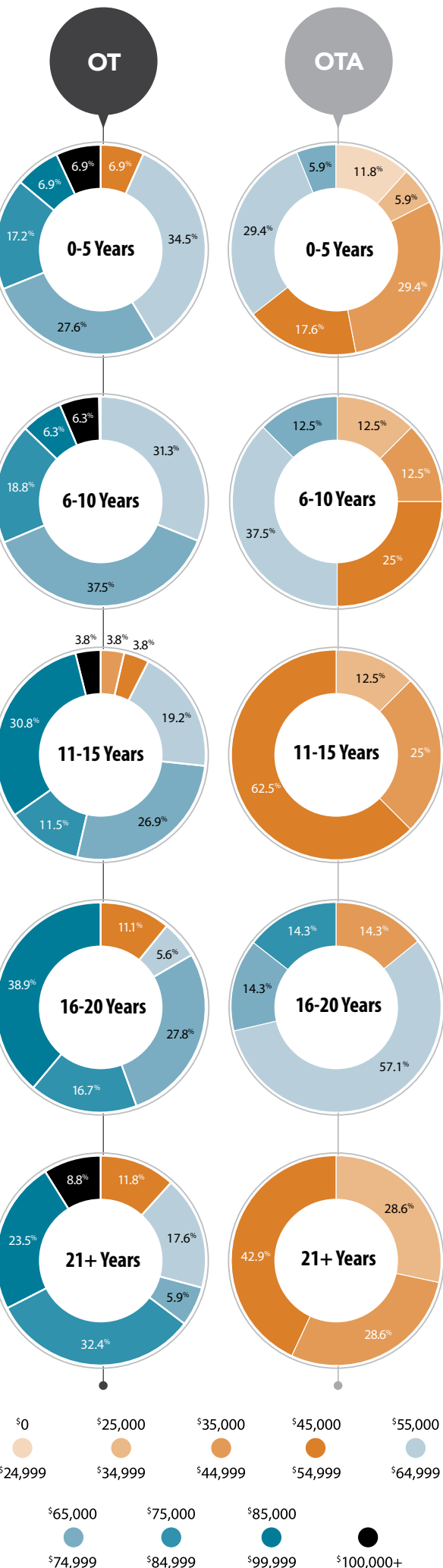
9% Only 9% of OTAs in the Midwest earn at least \$65,000.



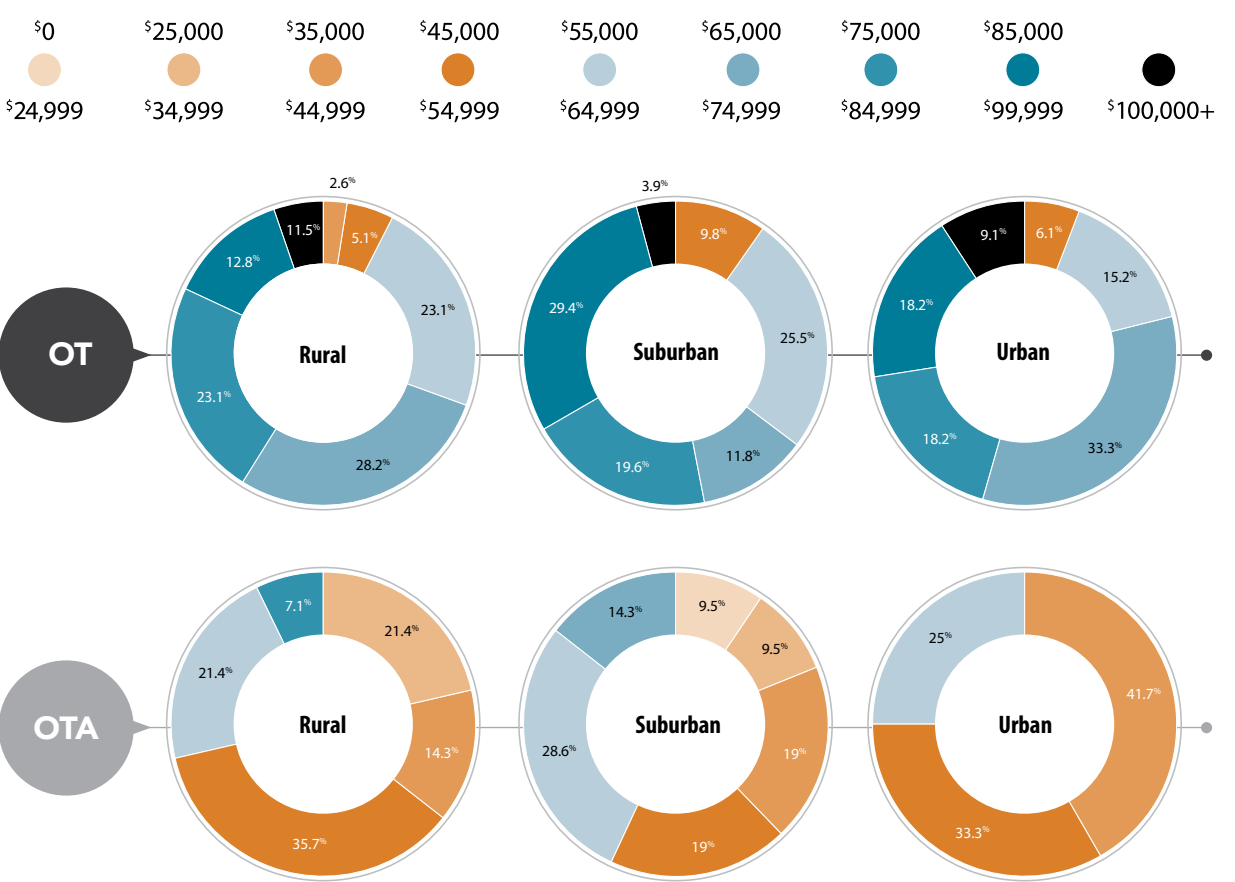
Midwest Salary Ranges By Degree Of the 123 OTs in the Midwest who responded to the degree question, 63% hold a master's, the largest component of the group. Over half (52%) of OTs in this region that hold a master's degree earn at least \$75,000.



Midwest Salary Ranges By Experience Years in the occupational therapy field typically result in consistently higher salaries. With over 21 years as an OT in the Midwest, the largest salary group is between \$75,000 and \$84,999 (32%). With at 11-15 years' experience, the largest group earns between \$65,000 and \$74,999 (27%).



Midwest Salary Ranges By Location Suburban OTs in the Midwest seem to fare best in the salary department, with 53% of this group earning over \$75,000. Suburban OTAs also reported the highest salary numbers with 43% earning at least \$55,000.



Midwest Salary Ranges By Role 86% of OT respondents in this region classify themselves as staff, with the highest concentration of staff OTs making \$55,000-\$64,999. 96% of OTA respondents classify as staff OTAs, with the highest group earning \$45,000-\$54,999 (27%).
