
## **2016 Salary Survey Results**

Every year at *ADVANCE*, we painstakingly gather data from across the country to produce our eagerly awaited Salary Survey. In addition to our national results, we also offer comprehensive breakdowns by region. 287 people who took our salary survey live in the West region (MT, WY, CO, UT, NM, AZ, NV, CA, OR, WA, ID, AK, and HI.). 125 of them (73%) were occupational therapists, and 46 (27%) were occupational therapy assistants. This is how the numbers break down for OTs and OTAs who live in the western region of The United States.
