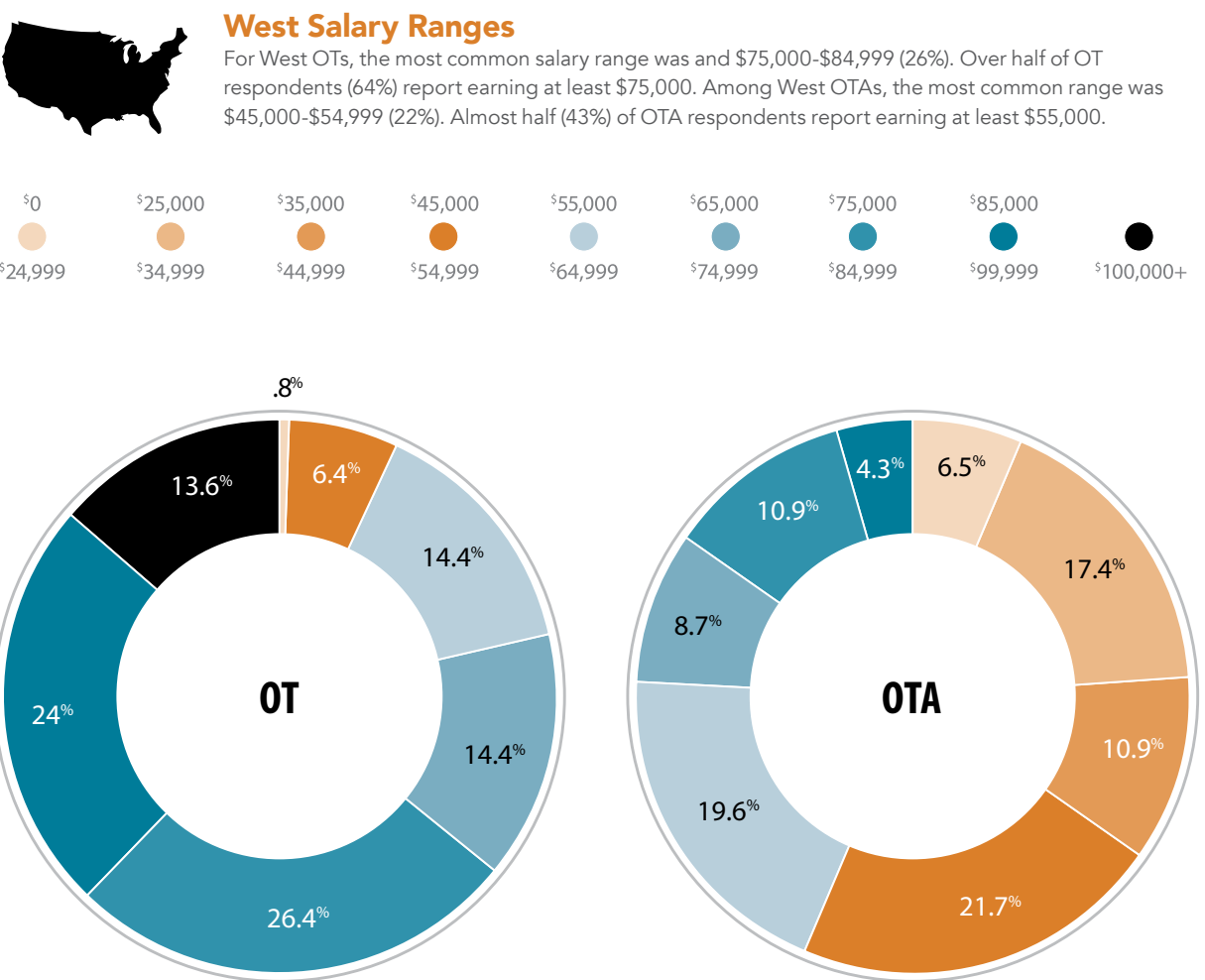


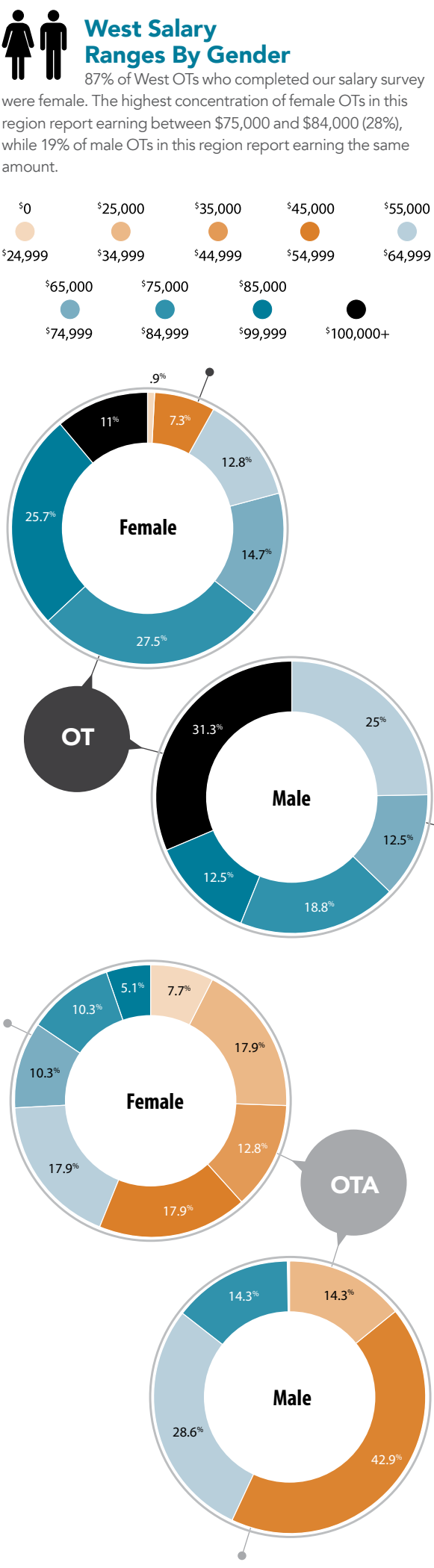
2016 Salary Survey Results

Every year at ADVANCE, we painstakingly gather data from across the country to produce our eagerly awaited Salary Survey. In addition to our national results, we also offer comprehensive breakdowns by region. 287 people who took our salary survey live in the West region (MT, WY, CO, UT, NM, AZ, NV, CA, OR, WA, ID, AK, and HI.). 125 of them (73%) were occupational therapists, and 46 (27%) were occupational therapy assistants. This is how the numbers break down for OTs and OTAs who live in the western region of The United States.

38% 38% of OTs in in this region report earning at least \$85,000.



24% 24% of OTAs in the West earn at least \$65,000.



**West Salary Ranges By Degree**

Of the 125 OTs in the West who responded to the degree question, 55% hold a master's, the largest component of the group. Over half (59%) of OTs in this region that hold a master's degree earn at least \$75,000.

24% 78% of OTAs in the West hold an associate's degree, with the largest concentration (28%) earning between \$45,000 and \$54,999.
